## WINE BY THE GLASS Gls/Btl

- **Bottega, Doc Brut, Prosecco,**  
Veneto, NV Italy **250.-/1,750.-**  
Sweet, pastry and a little floral. Fresh and Youthful.
- **Terres Dorees, Beaujolais Blanc**  
**Chardonnay,**  
Beaujolais, 2015 France. **270.-/1,850.-**  
Fresh peach, orange and a hint of smoky lees on the nose. Juicy and tightly focused.

## CHAMPAGNE

- **DOM PERIGNON,**  
France - 2009 **17,500.-**  
Lily of the valley perfume and scents of toasted brioche and almond rise from the glass. Hints of apricot, pear and grapefruit then inform a luscious and creamy yet strikingly delicate & refreshing palate.
- **G.H. Mumm, Brut Reims, France**  
(375 ml.) **2,500.-**  
(750ml.) **4,600.-**  
Brightly sparkling, light golden liquid with fine and elegant bubbles. The nose reveals aromas of ripe fresh fruit (white & yellow peaches, apricots), tropical notes (lychee and pineapple).
- **Autreau Grand Cru, Blanc de Blanc**  
**Chardonnay, France, NV** **3,200.-**  
The lemon yellow with gold and almond green glints is typical of the Chardonnay. The nose is combination of ripe citrus, buttery and flowery finish.
- **MOET & CHANDON 'Brut Imperial',**  
France - NV **5,890.-**  
Sparkling - Complex and Traditional. The vibrant intensity of green apple and citrus fruits. The freshness of mineral nuances the elegance of blond notes (brioche, cereal, free nuts).
- **MOET & CHANDON, Rose Imperial',**  
France - NV (WS 87) **5,990.-**  
Lively, intense bouquet of red fruits (wild strawberry, raspberry, cherry). Floral nuances of rose. A slight hint of pepper. The fleshiness and firmness of peach.
- **Veuve Cliquot Ponsardin, Brut**  
France - 93 WS **5,800.-**  
Sparkling - Complex and Traditional. Bright and lightly toasty, crushed hazelnut, and lemon meringue pie on the creamy bead.

*Produced from Chardonnay grapes in the traditional Champagne method, ages a minimum of 24 months, giving the wine a very refined mouthfeel. Ferrari Trento received 15 Gold Medals and the title of 'Best Winery: Producer of the Year 2019'.*

Trentino, Italy - NV **2,480.-**  
Clean and balance in taste, with a slight and pleasant finish of ripe fruit and a hint of bread crust.
- **FERRARI 'Maximum Rose', Chardonnay,**  
Trentino, Italy - NV **2,650.-**  
Dry, clean and elegant, with a delicate finish of sweet almonds. 60% Pinot Noir; 40% Chardonnay.

## SPARKING WINE

- **Bottega 'Doc Brut', Prosecco,**  
Veneto, IT - 2017 **1,750.-**  
Sweet, pastry and a little floral. Fresh and Youthful.
- **Bottega, 'Gold' Brut, Prosecco,**  
Veneto, 85WE NV Italy **2,500.-**  
Clear, fruity and flowery with scents of Golden apple, Williams pear, Acacia flowers and lily, elegant and fresh.
- **Domaine Pierre Luneau-Papin "L" Brut,**  
Loire Valley, NV France **1,850.-**  
From aperitif to dessert, throughout the meal and for tea time.
- **Bortolomiol, Filandia Rose Pinot Noir**  
Millesimato Riserva, Italy **1,950.-**  
Crisp and dry with flavors of dried cherry and apple cider intermingled. A delightful and refreshing aperitif.

### AUSTRIA

- **F.X. Pichler Durnsteiner Liebenberg, Grüner Veltliner, Wachau, 2012** **2,980.-**  
The notes show citrus aromas (lemon peel and grapefruit) complemented by stone fruit and fresh.

### AUSTRALIA

- **Sunnycliff, Sauvignon Blanc, Victoria, 2017** **1,650.-**  
A fresh and lively palate with rich flavours of melon and peach and a hint of grape fruit.
- **Katnook Founder's Block, Chardonnay, Coonawarra, 87RP 2017** **1,950.-**  
Aromas of green apples, passion fruit and zesty lime, taste of citrus and lychees with a natural freshness on the finish.

### FRANCE

- **Terres Dorees, (Jean Paul Brun) Beaujolais Blanc Chardonnay, France 2015** **1,850.-**  
Fresh peach, orange and a hint of smoky lees on the nose, juicy and tightly focused.
- **Domaine Pierre de La Grange, Vignes Muscadet, Loire, France 2014** **1,850.-**  
Green and flinty. Minerals character to the wine's structure. Fine weight & freshness. With the exception of Champagne, de La Grange make a superb aperitif and best to accompany with oysters.
- **Barton & Guestier, Chablis Chardonnay, 'Passeport', Burgundy** **2,600.-**  
Dry White wine and has a typical varietal characteristics.

### GERMANY

- **DREISSIGACKER 'Organic Trocken', Riesling, Rheinhessen, Germany** **1,850.-**  
Mature fruit on the candied flowers, nutty/buttery notes with a hint of tobacco. Nice acidity and noticeable warm alcohol on a good finish.

### ITALY

- **Vesovo Greco di Tufo, Greco Bianco, DOCG, Campania, Italy 90WE 2016** **1,850.-**  
The aromas and flavours are typically of lemons, pears and toasted almonds. The soil type (sulfur-tuffa rich volcanic and clay soils) impart a complex minerality.
- **Marco Felluga, Pinot Grigio, DOC Collio Friuli Venezia Giulia, Italy** **1,950.-**  
Rich and elegant fruit-forward style. Sharp and immediate bouquet with aromas of acacia flowers, apple, sweetness of bread crust and vanilla.

### NEW ZEALAND

- **Cloudy Bay Marlborough, New Zealand, N2- 2017** **4,400.-**  
Fresh lemon, white grapefruit and lime blossoms with hints of sage and wild thyme. Medium bodied, dry, crisp with plenty of citrusy zing in the mouth, the finish is long and steely.
- **Hunky Dory, Sauvignon Blanc New Zealand 2018** **1,700.-**  
Succulent & tropical fruit notes. Full flavored lingering finish - designed to meet expectations of a true Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc.
- **Pounamu, Sauvignon Blanc, Special Selection, Marlborough, New Zealand, 92WS 2017** **2,200.-**  
From Cloudy Bay's former head winemaker. Intense and generous with peach, mango and green papaya flavours set on a crisp, vibrantly juicy frame.

### SOUTH AFRICA

- **Delheim, Chenin Blanc, Stellenbosch, 87WS 2017** **1,600.-**  
Tropical fruits and complex spice. The white nose shows intense citrus, quince and pineapple notes.

### AUSTRALIA

- **Katnook Estate, Shiraz 'Founder's Block', Coonawarra.** 87WS 2015 **2,300.-**  
Good-value red with lively blackberry, cherry and plum notes finessed with a helping of mocha and vanillin oak.

### CALIFORNIA

- **McManis, Cabernet Sauvignon.** 84WS 2015 **2,000.-**  
Dark garnet in color with a bouquet is full of dark berry fruit such as blueberry and black cherry.
- **Bogle Vineyards, Merlot.** 87WS 2015 **1,900.-**  
Full-bodied and big, the resulting wine resonates with bright cherry and dried herbs on the nose.
- **Bogle, Vineyards, Pinot Noir.** WS87 2015 **1,900.-**  
Heady scents of ripe summer strawberries make a lovely first impression, while hints of crushed violets and sweet dried herbs resonate on the nose.
- **Francis Coppola, 'Diamond Collection' "Claret" Cabernet Sauvignon/ Petit Verdot/ Merlot/Malbec.** 87WS 2015 **2,500.-**  
This wine is rich, firmly structured wine that offers lively aromas and succulent flavors of wild berries, plum, and anise.

### CHILE

- **Carta Vieja, Cabernet Sauvignon 'Limited Release' Reserva,** Loncomilla Valley. 87RP 2015 **1,500.-**  
Soft notes of pepper, Tobacco, and vanilla are interviewing with a deep and sweet black fruits.
- **Carta Vieja, Syrah 'Limited Release' Reserva,** Loncomilla Valley. 88RP 2016 **1,500.-**  
Contains pleasant aromas of black plum, blackberry and chocolate with light touches of vanilla.
- **Calicanto, Cab Sau/ Carménère/ Syrah/ Petit Verdot,** Maipo Valley. 89RP 2015 **1,850.-**  
A fresh and clean red with light plum and berry character. Medium body. Light chocolate and tile undertone.

This is not a fruit bomb, but rather shows notes of soil, leather and tobacco. Black currant & ripe blueberries, a hint of smoke, smooth astringency, silky tannins, medium-long finish.

### ITALY

- **Vesevo, Aglianico, Beneventano IGT,** Campania. 85WE 2011 **1,650.-**  
Rich aromas of chocolate, mocha and ripe black cherries, Tannins beautifully and finishes on a long.

### NEW ZEALAND

- **APoPo, Pinot Noir,** Marlborough. 2016 **1,650.-**  
Aromatic cherry, bright red berry and juicy black plum, with a lingering, smooth and seductive texture.
