



Covid-19 Advisory

The safety and well-being of our guests and staff are of utmost priority to us. Thus, in view of the evolving COVID-19 situation, we have put in place the following enhanced precautionary measures to ensure Wild Honey remains safe for all.

Effective from 25 March 2020, guests who meet the below criteria will unfortunately be unable to dine at the restaurant:

- Guests who have been in contact with a confirmed COVID-19 patient in the last 14 days.
- Guests who have been to Mainland China in the last 14 days.
- Guests who have travelled or returned from overseas in the last 14 days.
- Guests who are currently serving a Stay-Home Notice (SHN) or quarantine.
- Guests with symptoms that include dry cough, fever, body aches, headaches, sore throat, runny nose, tiredness or shortness of breath.

In addition, health screening forms may be required to be completed before guests are seated. We seek your understanding during this challenging period.
