

LANTERN




Lantern derives its name from the 1933 Clifford Pier which was popularly known to locals as "Ang Teng Beh Tao" (Red Lantern Pier in Hokkien) for the red oil lamp that used to hang from the Pier to alert ships as they entered the harbour. Overlooking the revitalised Clifford Pier today, Lantern features a custom-designed circular bar counter that is shaped like a lantern with bronze metal "fins".
