### BRUT

- 4. Ayala Brut Majeur Champagne N.V.** **\$118**  
France, Champagne  
*Light gold with abundant of fine bubbles. The nose is open, expressive and delicate, unveiling notes of citrus, flowers and white fruits. Combining freshness of vinosity, the palate is balanced, precise, fruity and characterised by a long finish.*  
*Varietal: Chardonnay Pinot Meunier, Pinot Noir*
- 5. Delamotte Brut Champagne N.V.** **\$148**  
France, Champagne  
*Enticing aromas of orchard fruits mingled with soft scents of hazelnuts and pain grillé greet the nose. The wine truly turns on its charm with crisp, clean, mineral-driven flavours that complement the wine's delicate fruit and delightfully toasty elements. Refreshing and beautifully balanced.*  
*Varietal: Chardonnay Pinot Meunier, Pinot Noir*
- 6. Cornerstone Sparkling Brut** **\$68**  
France, Languedoc-Roussillon  
*Fresh and youthful, the most noble of grapes are selected to give this sparkling wine a delicate fruitiness and a remarkable and brilliant character.*

7. **Astoria Lounge Prosecco N.V.** **\$84**  
Italy, Veneto  
*Very fine and persistent. Straw yellow in colour with greenish reflections. Floral aromas, along with generous amounts of pear and golden delicious apple. Creamy, full, and harmonious on the palate.*  
*Varietal: Glera, Chardonnay*
8. **Sartori Prosecco Extra Dry "Veronello" DOC N.V.** **\$72**  
Italy, Veneto  
*Pale straw colour with greenish reflections. Limpid and crystal-clear with fine and persistent perlage. Hints of apple followed by floral aromas of wisteria and acacia. Slightly aromatic, full, rounded, fresh, with a well-flavoured and long aftertaste. Excellent as an aperitif, elegant companion to all sorts of appetizers and first courses.*  
*Varietal: Glera*
9. **Medici Ermete Lambrusco Rose' Dry "Phermento" DOC** **\$118**  
Italy, Emilia Romagna  
*Deep pink with fine perlage. Froth is fine, rich and persistent. Bouquets of raspberry, red fruits. Dry, fruity and vibrant, perfect to accompany dishes like charcuteries, vegetal or fish tempura.*  
*Varietal: Lambrusco di Sorbara*

## DEMI SEC

10. **Cantine Volpi Moscato Piemonte DOC** **\$72**  
Italy, Piedmont  
*Pale golden yellow. Intensely aromatic notes of ripe citrus fruits, honey and orange blossoms. On the palate, the sweet melon, pear, and floral flavours are balanced by refreshing acidity.*
11. **Bersano Monteolivo Moscato d'Asti DOCG** **\$84**  
Italy, Piedmont  
*Straw yellow colour with light golden reflections. Intense and aromatic bouquet, typical of Moscato grapes with hints of peach, sage and lemon with a delicate finishing of acacia flowers. Gently sweet, with good and delicate fizz and an elegant aftertaste.*
12. **Medici Ermete Lambrusco Reggiano "Quercioli" DOC N.V.** **\$62**  
Italy, Emilia Romagna  
*Dark violet, fruity and persistent with raspberries, boysenberries, blackberries and roses aromas. Big and fruity strawberries, raspberries, blackberries, and cherries, medium bodied with soft tannins. Best paired with spicy dishes, sandwiches, pizza, pasta, burgers and grilled sausages.*  
*Varietal: Lambrusco Salamino*



# WHITE WINES

## DRY

13. **Librandi Ciro' Rosato DOC** **\$78**  
Italy, Calabria  
*Bright pink-red. Delicate fragrance of white rose and red berry with a light anise note. Savoury and refreshing, it delivers notes of red raspberry, morello cherry, orange zest and white pepper brightened by tangy acidity. Best paired with salad, white meat and seafood.*  
*Varietal: Gaglioppo*
14. **Luigi Leonardo Pinot Grigio delle Venezie** **\$82**  
Italy, Veneto  
*This wine has a bright straw-yellow with coppery reflections, inviting flavour. Consume with delicate pasta dishes, fish and white meat.*
15. **Astoria Alisia Pinot Grigio** **\$88**  
Italy, Veneto  
*Fresh yet soft on the palate, with hay and nutty notes alongside delicate peppery spice with delicious pear fruit and a perfect level of acidity to refresh the palate.*
16. **Elderton Eden Valley Riesling** **\$108**  
Australia, Eden Valley  
*Dry, delicate and zesty. Vibrant pale green in colour. Attractive white florals and lemon zest in the nose. Delicate white florals, green apple and fresh lemon, supported by a zesty acid backbone, leading to a bright chalky finish.*

## OFF DRY

17. **Gunderloch Fritz's Riesling** **\$68**  
Germany, Rheinhessen  
*Floral, orange peel with a nice streak of acidity. Vivacious, fruity, and off-dry.*
18. **Deetlefs Stonecross Chardonnay** **\$58**  
South Africa, Western Cape  
*Light pale straw in colour. Combination of lime, pineapple, pear, peach and apricot aromas intrigue on the nose. The taste is fresh and zesty with an abundance of citrus, pineapple and apricot flavours. The wine has a well-rounded lingering finish. Best paired with pasta & light dishes like soufflé.*
19. **Richard Hamilton Almond Grove Chardonnay** **\$108**  
Australia, McLaren Vale  
*Pale light yellow with vibrant greens. Nectarine and peach fruit nose with lovely complexity from French oak maturation. Flavoursome Chardonnay with good persistence and length, finishing with a clean soft acidity.*
20. **Stella Bella Chardonnay** **\$106**  
Australia, Margaret River  
*Bright pale straw. Savoury complex aromas of nougat and gunflint are complimented by fresh fruit aromas of lime rind, grapefruit, musk and jasmine. Wild fermentation and high solids add complexity, which together with well-balanced new oak, provide a wine of distinct southern Margaret River character. Displaying our signature spring water liveliness, this wine is driven by lemon, lime and grapefruit. A hint of saline captures the southern Margaret River minerality. The textural finish has lingering nuttiness and salivating complexity.*



21. **La Chamiza Chardonnay** **\$84**  
 Argentina, Mendoza  
*Surprisingly fresh and fruity with mineral, pear and a splash of honey. Fresh and clean attack on the palate with green apple, melon and grapefruit flavours. Sweet but balanced.*
22. **Sartori Chardonnay "Il Sole" Organic IGT** **\$58**  
 Italy, Veneto  
*Yellow-straw in colour. Lush fruity bouquet. Inviting and balanced flavour. An ideal accompaniment for rich fish, shellfish, and light risottos.*
23. **Domaine Christian Moreau Chablis** **\$108**  
 France, Burgundy  
*Generous, luscious white peach and honeydew melon along with the tartness and pungency of grapefruit, nettle and white currant. Creamy, chalk-dusted yet persistently refreshing palate.*  
*Varietal: Chardonnay*
24. **Jip Jip Rocks Chardonnay** **\$98**  
 Australia, Padthaway  
*Light yellow, classic nose of lemon. Stonefruit and melon. Clean and Crisp.*
25. **Torrevento Fiano "Torre del Falco" IGT** **\$78**  
 Italy, Puglia  
*Straw yellow with slight greenish glints. Fine and delicate bouquet with notes of wild flowers and fruit, intense and fresh. To be drunk young, excellent as an aperitif or to accompany boiled or grilled fish, crustaceans and seafood.*
26. **Fontanafredda le Righe Gavi di Gavi** **\$116**  
 Italy, Piedmont  
*Straw yellow with greenish highlights, with an intense bouquet featuring acacia flowers, lemon, lily of the valley and bitter apples. Its nicely dry taste is full, well-balanced and elegant. Ideal pairing with starters and light meals.*  
*Varietal: Cortese*

## MEDIUM DRY

27. **Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc** **\$98**  
 New Zealand, Marlborough  
*With a playful freshness accompanied by a light gooseberry and green apple finish, this is a truly versatile wine that will suit any occasion. A true delight.*
28. **Baron Philippe de Rothschild Sauvignon Blanc Pays D'Oc** **\$84**  
 France, Bordeaux  
*This wine has a refined, elegant nose that opens on blossom aromas and delicate notes of ripe fruit. Round and full on the palate, with a pleasing crispness, its delicate citrus fruit flavours are set off by a touch of minerality that brings freshness and character. A rich and long finish expresses all the personality and refinement of the variety.*
29. **Domaine Vincent Delaporte Sancerre Chavignol** **\$128**  
 France, Loire  
*The nose is expressive and complex with rhubarb, blackcurrant, and kiwi notes, while the entry is soft and round. Well balanced and harmonious, it ends with a clean lingering finish.*  
*Varietal: Sauvignon Blanc*



- 30. Sileni Cellar Selection Sauvignon Blanc** **\$88**  
New Zealand, Marlborough  
*This wine has ripe aromas and flavours of passion fruit, tropical fruit with gooseberry undertones. The palate is balanced, has a beautiful freshness and a long finish.*

## FRUITY

- 31. Château Le Gay Bordeaux Blanc** **\$68**  
France, Bordeaux  
*Le Gay is a massive, masculine Pomerol, very much in the style of Gazin, but showing much more minerality, abundant blue and black fruits, a full-bodied mouthfeel, and loads of tannin in a youthful, backward style.*  
*Varietal: Semillion, Sauvignon Blanc*

- 32. Montmeyrac Grande Selection Blanc** **\$58**  
France, South West  
*With its floral and slightly woody nose, reveals a fresh and balanced palate. It will go perfectly with salads or fish.*  
*Varietal: Semillion, Sauvignon Blanc*

## SWEET

- 33. Sartori Vernus Recioto di Soave** **\$168**  
Italy, Veneto  
*Gold-straw in colour. Rich, seductive bouquet of quince, apricot, and dried figs, Full bodied with unctuous notes of apricots, almonds, caramel and a hint of spice.*  
*Varietal: Garganega, Trebbiano di Soave*

- 34. Tempus Two Pewter Botrytis Semillon** **\$148**  
Australia, Hunter Valley  
*Rich and opulent with a refreshing citrus lift - the quintessence of botrytis Semillon. Citrus fruit marmalade flavours combine with apricot and hints of wild honey. The wine displays restrained acidity and light drying tannins which are balanced by the concentration of luscious natural sugars resulting in overall elegance and finesse. Rich aromas of dried apricot, zesty citrus fruit marmalade and hints of honey.*

## RED WINE

### LIGHT- MEDIUM

- 35. Astoria Caranto Pinot Noir IGT** **\$88**  
Italy, Veneto  
*Astoria Caranto Pinot Noir is ruby red in colour, but not very dark. The bouquet is intense, pleasant, reminding of strawberry and raspberry. The finish is harmonic, savoury, with body without excesses.*
- 36. Map Maker Pinot Noir** **\$98**  
New Zealand, Marlborough  
*This wine has lovely aromas of ripe black cherries and wild violets. In the mouth the wine has a grainy tannin structure and is intensely flavoured with sweet cherries, cedarwood and savoury characters such as dried herbs and wild game flavours. This is a feminine style Pinot Noir with an 'old world' elegance and a mineral lingering finish.*
- 37. Sileni Cellar Selection Pinot Noir** **\$88**  
New Zealand, Hawke's Bay  
*Concentrated black cherry and dark berry aromas which follow through to the palate where dark berry fruit and cherry flavours are supported by soft tannins.*



- 38. Pascal Jolivet Pinot Noir Attitude** **\$84**  
 France, Loire Valley  
*"Attitude" Pinot Noir presents a brilliant ruby colour with elegant aromas of red fruits, cherries and blackcurrants. Spicy notes lead to a very elegant finale where balance and finesse, fruit and subtly woody flavours blend harmoniously and transcribe the nobility of the Pinot Noir.*
- 39. Stefano Brunello di Montalcino** **\$226**  
 Italy, Tuscany  
*Dry light bodied wine with a brilliant red garnet hue. Fine bouquet of cherry, plum and citrus notes with hints of vanilla and spice. Slightly tannic but still balanced with a little hint of earthiness that brings complexity.*  
*Varietal: Sangiovese*
- 40. Domaine Lafleur No.2 Pomerol** **\$180**  
 France, Bordeaux  
*Intense red colour, with violet reflection when young. Tannins are very soft. In mouth, the wine is very harmonious, well-balanced, with black currant aromas, raspberries and hint of clove in the end.*  
*Varietal: Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot*
- 41. Sartori Rosso delle Venezie "L'Appassione" LGT** **\$76**  
 Italy, Veneto  
*Vivid garnet red. Intense and persistent bouquet of red fruits and spices, tobacco and leather. Full bodied, round, pleasing, slightly dry and velvety, with a harmonious soft-textured body. Ideal match for main courses, grilled meats, roasts, savoury cheese and smoked ham.*  
*Varietal: Corvina*
- 42. Montmeyrac Grande Selection Rouge** **\$56**  
 France, South West  
*Light ruby colour with pale light rim. Red fruits, oak, and a bit of smoky aromas. Dry, medium to high acidity, that lowers a bit after it cools down. Low tannins, a bit soft, overwhelmed by acidity in excess.*  
*Varietal: Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon*

## MEDIUM BODIED

- 43. Château La Croix La Bastienne** **\$108**  
 France, Bordeaux  
*The appearance is clear deep ruby. The nose is aromatic and aged with aromas of cherry, cassis, purplish fruit and slight jammy. The palate is dry, full bodied, smooth acidity medium and round tannins, good balance, powerful flavours of jam, cassis, black fruit and slight pencil shavings, long finish.*
- 44. Château D'Arthus Bordeaux** **\$142**  
 France, Bordeaux  
*With blackcurrant and plum notes, this medium-bodied red wine from France's Bordeaux region has a plush mouthfeel and subtle yet elegant structure.*  
*Varietal: Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot*
- 45. Tenuta San Guido Le Difese** **\$136**  
 Italy, Tuscany  
*Bright red with purple nuances. Crisp acidity and pleasant palate of every day wine drinking, with juicy red fruits. A very good wine that is meant to be enjoyed young.*  
*Varietal: Cabernet Sauvignon, Sangiovese*



**46. Richard Hamilton Colton's GSM** **\$108**  
Australia, McLaren Vale  
*Medium to full red with attractive crimson. Subtle use of oak allows the fruit to shine through to reveal attractive hints of boiled fruit cake with cinnamon and cloves. Put it in big glass and savour the fragrance. A beautifully round palate with silky tannins and soft acidity, this wine has lovely persistence and length.*  
*Varietal: Grenache, Shiraz, Mourvèdre*

**47. Argiano Rosso di Montalcino** **\$88**  
Italy, Tuscany  
*Aromas of menthol, dark berry, cellar floor and a whiff of humid underbrush lead the nose. Reflecting the cool, wet vintage, the light-bodied palate is a bit diluted, offering dark cherry and a hint of anise alongside vibrant acidity and close-grained, loose-knit tannins.*  
*Varietal: Sangiovese*

**48. Viña Santiago Carménère** **\$56**  
Chile, Central Valley  
*Fantastically beautiful, medium-bodied, fruit-forward wine. With gentle tannins, and deep crimson colours, you can expect an array of berries, red fruits, spice, smokiness and earth on both the nose and palate.*

**49. Benatti Gadi Valpolicella Classico** **\$106**  
Italy, Veneto  
*Deep red with garnet nuances. Ripe cherry, plum, vanilla aromas, a structured wine with supple tannins and appropriate acidity.*  
*Varietal: Corvina, Corvinone, Rondinella*

## MEDIUM TO HEAVY BODIED

**50. Deetlefs Stonecross Merlot Pinotage** **\$68**  
South Africa, Breedekloof  
*Dark red colour. Red cherries, strawberries, prunes, plums and a hint of mint add to the complexity. Clean fruity entry with good firm tannins; still young and tight but well-rounded. Good lingering aftertaste, with exceptional fruit expression.*

**51. Argiano Brunello Di Montalcino** **\$208**  
Italy, Tuscany  
*Coffee, toast, nut, forest floor and fleshy plum aromas waft out of the glass. The big, round palate offers dried black cherry, blackberry jam, liquorice and chopped herb alongside ripe, loosely knit tannins. It's straightforward for a Brunello but it has a juicy, immediate appeal.*  
*Varietal: Sangiovese*

**52. Siglo Tempranillo N.V.** **\$78**  
Spain, Rioja  
*Intense cherry red colour with high robe and garnet rim. Medium-high intensity and stands out for its red and black fruit in perfect harmony with the spices, eucalyptus and elegant toasted.*

**53. Gregorio Martinez Gran Reserva DOC** **\$143**  
Spain, Rioja  
*Medium intense cherry red hue with ruby red rim, clean and bright. The nose is redolent of sweet red fruit, subtle balsamic hints and touches of hard wood (cedar), tobacco and spices (cardamom, cinnamon); a certain earthiness appears with oxygenation, without ever losing its freshness and depth. In the mouth it is fresh with silky and velvety tannins which give way to intense red fruit; it is long, with an incredibly persistent aftertaste reminiscent of spicy red fruit.*  
*Varietal: Tempranillo*



- 54. Château Les Ormes de Pez** **\$210**  
France, Bordeaux, Saint-Estephe  
*Château Ormes de Pez 2016 is rich, fine and elegant. The nose is rather fruity, with aromas of Morello cherries, blackberries and blackcurrants with a subtle note of liquorice. A full-bodied fresh wine, with silky tannins and an incredibly long finish.*  
*Varietal: Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc*
- 55. Caillard Mataro Limited Release** **\$198**  
Australia, Barossa Valley  
*Attractive crimson colours, fresh blackberry, cranberry, herb garden, star anise aromas, generous slinky graphite textures, underlying spicy, grilled nut, chinotto notes and persistent linear freshness. With one year's bottle age the fruit, oak and tannins have folded gently to bring a beautiful inky texture and complexity.*  
*Varietal: Mourvèdre*
- 56. Vina Santiago Gran Reserva** **\$144**  
Chile, Colchagua Valley  
*With a bright and intense ruby colour. This easy drinking young wine is perfect for beginners. Fruit forward and intense aromas perfectly combined with soft and elegant medium body.*  
*Varietal: Carménère*
- 57. Castello Trebbio Chianti Superior** **\$98**  
Italy, Tuscany  
*Deep ruby red with appealing aromas of small red berries, hints of flowers and spice. Medium-bodied and well-balanced with velvety tannins.*  
*Varietal: Sangiovese, Colorino*
- 58. Château Le Gay Bordeaux Superieur** **\$72**  
France, Bordeaux  
*Deep red colour. Intense aroma of vanilla, sweet spices and delicate woody notes. Beautifully balanced, round and supple on the palate. Ripe and well blended tannins. Velvety finish. Perfect with spicy, roasted meats.*  
*Varietal: Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot*
- 59. Valvirginio Chianti Riserva** **\$108**  
Italy, Chianti  
*Dusty plum colour in the glass. Lots of cherry and alcohol on the nose. Front is red fruit forward. Mid-palate has sting flavours of balsamic. The finish has soft tannins, a bit of soil, and hint of spice.*  
*Varietal: Merlot, Sangiovese*
- 60. Baron Philippe de Rothschild, Pays d'Oc Merlot** **\$88**  
France, Bordeaux  
*Merlot has expansive fruit flavours and rounded tannins, with an apparent softness that enables the wines to reach their peak rapidly. A deep ruby red. The nose reveals red fruit aromas, subtly mingled with notes of violet, spice and pepper. The attack is supple and round, with an attractive intensity of flavour supported by silky tannins, leading into a dense and succulent mid-palate and a long, highly elegant finish.*



## HEAVY BODIED

- 61. Corte Giara Valpolicella** **\$88**  
Italy, Veneto  
*Corvina Veronese 75% and Rondinella 25% intense and inviting ruby red. Hints of cherries and pepper are particularly enjoyable in this wine, followed by subtle nuances of officinal herbs. Full-bodied and well-balanced. The traditional acidic note combines well with the softness of the fruit to form a satisfying contrast and produce a supple, feisty wine.*  
*Varietal: Corvina, Rondinella*
- 62. Château Grand Mayne** **\$278**  
France, Saint-Emilion  
*Medium to deep garnet-purple coloured, the 2016 Grand Mayne features fragrant kirsch, redcurrant jelly and black plums scents with touches of garrigue, mossy bark and Sichuan pepper. Full-bodied, rich and densely laden with vibrant red and black fruits, it has a plush frame and very long, earth-laced finish.*  
*Varietal: Merlot, Cabernet Franc*
- 63. Bordeaux Superieur Rouge Vin de Bordeaux** **\$68**  
France, Bordeaux  
*Lovely dark hue with a touch of youth. Nose marked by oak overtones between notes of graphite and roasted coffee. More of the same on the palate, where the fruit is relegated to the background. The wine is balanced although the ageing aromas dominate excessively.*  
*Varietal: Merlot, Cabernet Franc, Cabernet Sauvignon, Carménère*
- 64. Château Ducasse Graves** **\$84**  
France, Bordeaux  
*Exhibits an especially deep purple robe and enticing aromas of black fruits, cassis, mulberry, unsmoked tobacco and supple earth tones that tantalize the nose and satiate the palate. Dry, yet rich with the quintessential savour of Graves, the 2016 Château Ducasse offers a wealth of blackberry and currant fruit, cedar, herbs and wood smoke on the palate to complement its firm tannins.*  
*Varietal: Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, Merlot*
- 65. Richard Hamilton Little Road Shiraz** **\$108**  
Australia, McLaren Vale  
*Bright, full, rich red. Dark brooding black olive and plum nose augmented with vanilla and hints of nutmeg through aging in French and American oak. Full bodied, richly flavoured palate showing attractive persistence of flavour with a round mid palate structure and a backbone of fine grained, silky tannins.*



## HEAVY TO FULL

- 66. Xavier Côtes du Rhône Rouge** **\$88**  
France, Rhone Valley  
*Has a rich ruby colour with crimson hues. The nose is intense and shows red fruits, black fruits, flowers and spices. The palate is spacious, very silky, powerful and generous.*  
*Varietal: Grenache, Syrah, Mourvèdre*
- 67. Terroirs Tuscany Sangiovese** **\$88**  
Italy, Tuscany  
*Produced in Tuscany, this Sangiovese is full-bodied with silky tannins and has aromas of ripe cherries culminating in a stylish finish. Goes beautifully with steak and grilled pork ribs.*
- 68. Jip Jip Rocks Shiraz** **\$98**  
South Australia, Padthaway  
*Full bodied and dry. Jip Jip Rocks Shiraz is packed with an explosion of ripe dark berry fruits on the palate.*
- 69. La Magia Brunello Di Montalcino DOCG** **\$218**  
Italy, Tuscany  
*The colour is ruby red tending towards garnet, with typical red berry fruit opening out on the nose and in the mouth, mineral overtones, delicate spices, supported by generous acidity, restrained tannin and a long finish.*  
*Varietal: Sangiovese*
- 70. Xavier Châteauneuf du Pape Anonyme** **\$218**  
France, Rhone Valley  
*Shows hints of mocha and toast on the nose, but the blackberry and red plum fruit is mouth watering and fresh, richly concentrated and spicy. Full-bodied, it manages to be ripe, silky and concentrated, while remaining crisp on the lengthy finish.*  
*Varietal: Grenache, Mourvèdre*
- 71. Château de la Font du Loup Côtes du Rhône Signature** **\$98**  
France, Rhone Valley  
*As a product of 50-year-old vines, the Signature is much more approachable than its Rhône contemporaries. It is filled with sweet red and black fruit wrapped up in silky tannins.*  
*Varietal: Grenache, Syrah*
- 72. Yangarra Estate Shiraz** **\$165**  
Australia, McLaren Vale  
*This wine is all about texture. The meaty blueberry hint is sometimes like prosciutto or other dark charcuterie meats; the figgy base tones provide a solid base flavour, the cleansing natural acidity working with the tannins to draw the finish out to a delicious taper with a long aftertaste where those cherries evident in the bouquet re-emerge, sinuous and more-ish.*



## FULL BODIED

- 73. Benatti Valtramigna Amarone Della Valpolicella** **\$216**  
Italy, Veneto  
*Deep red with violet shades with intense scents of stew fruit and jam. On the palate it's very elegant thanks to the harmonious balance between power and softness. Complex finish, with clear scents of jam (cherries, blackberries, raspberries) and intense spicy notes.*
