FRANCE

FR4 2017 E.Guigal Cotes du Rhone Rouge **S\$38**
Rhone

It's bright and primary, with cherry fruit, hint of almond paste on the crisp finish.

FR15 Jean Pierre Moueix Saint Emilion **S\$58**
Bordeaux

'Jean-Pierre Moueix', a range of wines from Bordeaux, Saint-Émilion, and Pomerol, is crafted with care to express the nuances of fruit and terroir from these storied appellations.

FR16 2019 Faiveley Mercurey Vieilles Vignes Roug **S\$58**
Burgundy

Exceptionally aromatic wine that offers a true reflection of its Mercurey terroirs. The palate reveals a smooth, fruity attack and evolves towards notes of ripe red berries and a touch of vanilla. Well-integrated wood that brings a pleasant complexity.

FR17 2018 Domaine Vacheron Sancerre Rouge **S\$68**
Loire Valley

Opens with an intense, spicy, well-concentrated, still somewhat untamed and smoky, reductive and fleshy bouquet of ripe black cherries, berries, chocolate and pepper. Full-bodied, intense and juicy on the palate, with silky tannins.

FR18 2017 Les Legendes R Pauillac **S\$75**
Bordeaux

The nose is complex and discreet, the bouquet will further develop upon ageing. Wirling of the glass will reveal notes of underwood, spices and pencil lead delicately woven together.

FR19 2018 Moulin de Duhart **S\$80**
Burgundy

Opens with gregarious scents of black cherries, warm plums and freshly crushed blackcurrants with touches of camphor, pencil lead and cloves plus a waft of lavender, medium to full-bodied.

FR20 2018 Lagrange Pomerol **S\$88**
Bordeaux

There's a slightly herbal overtone to the citrusy aromas. Generous peach and melon notes on the medium to full-bodied palate, with an anise note on the finish.

FR21 2016 Remoissenet Beaune 1er Cru Les Teurons **S\$105**
Burgundy

This is the first wine to display any appreciable amount of reduction on the moderately oaked nose. Otherwise there is evident muscle to the vibrant and intense yet still suave medium-bodied flavors that coat the palate with dry extract on the slightly firmer finish that is presently more completely balanced.

FR22 2016 E.Guigal Chateauneuf du Pape **S\$98**
Rhone

Baking spices, cola and raspberry notes all appear on the nose. It's full-bodied and velvety, folding in hints of french roast and dark chocolate on the lingering finish.

FR23 2015 Reserve de la Comtesse **S\$118**
Bordeaux

It shows a lot of vibrant red berries, blackberries and darker plum fruits. The palate is impressive for the vibrant and lively acidity cast amid sturdy but supple tannins.

FR24 2017 Faiveley NSG 1er Cru Porets St Georges **S\$128**
Burgundy

The nose discloses black fruits, toasty notes and a hint of oak. The smooth, round attack gives way to a powerful and structured mid-palate.

- FR25** 2004 Leoville Poyferre **S\$188**
Bordeaux
Made in a more floral, supple, Margaux-like style, the deep ruby/purple-hued and exhibits sweet, broad flavors, and plenty of tannin lurking beneath the surface.
- FR26** 2005 Beausejour Duffau **S\$198**
Bordeaux
Extravagant aromas of blueberry jam, kirsch, roast coffee and sexy oak, slightly liqueur-like in its huge Ripeness. Wonderfully dense, sweet and powerful.
- FR27** 2006 Canon **S\$188**
Bordeaux
Has a vivid, kirsch and wild strawberry bouquet with touches of orange zest and marmalade, a touch of mushroom in the background. The palate is medium-bodied with supple ripe black cherry and blackcurrant fruit, sage and melted tar.
- FR28** 2007 Carbonnieux Rouge **S\$142**
Bordeaux
This dark ruby/purple-hued 2007 reveals notes of sandalwood, spice box, black currants, sweet cherries and truffles. Spicy, round, and generous with a nicely layered mouthfeel, velvety tannins.
- FR29** 2007 Pape Clement Rouge **S\$198**
Bordeaux
Medium ruby-red. Exotic aromas of currant, plum, tobacco, minerals, smoke and spices, complicated by hints of cherry-cola and pepper.
- FR30** 2008 Clos Du Marquis **S\$138**
Bordeaux
Fresh and balanced, sporting just the right amount of dryness on the cassis-driven finish that balanced with the fruit, lending it a "breezy" and unassuming character that suits it down to the ground.
- FR31** 2009 Les Pagodes de Cos **S\$138**
Bordeaux
Full-bodied, round and exhibits lots of creme de cassis and floral notes intermixed with hints of wood/barrique and spice.
- FR32** 2010 Malescot St Exupery **S\$168**
Bordeaux
Raspberry coulis and kirsch over a cassis and warm plums core with a touch of pencil shavings. Medium to full-bodied, the palate is packed with juicy red and black fruits.
- FR33** 2011 Haut Bailly **S\$158**
Bordeaux
Noble set of aromatics consisting of red and black currants, sweet cherries, graphite, truffles & a faint hint of wood spice.
- FR50** 2011 Grand Puy Lacoste **S\$138**
Bordeaux
The dense ruby/purple coloured of 2011 Grand Puy Lacoste exhibits a charming, open knit bouquet of red & black fruits. It's a savoury, medium bodied, flavourful, well-endowed Paulillac from Xavier Borie. RP 91pts

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- AR1** 2019 Aruma **S\$45**
Mendoza
The robe is deep red with hints of violet. The nose reveals aromas of plum and red fruit. The palate is fresh and elegant, with remarkable balance between tannins, acidity and alcohol.
- AR2** 2018 Amancaya **S\$50**
Mendoza
Deep ruby color. The nose is intense with notes of white flowers, red cherries and figs. The palate is juicy and complex with hints of cloves and other spices. This well balanced wine is an elegant expression of the blend.

AR3 2017 Caro
Mendoza

S\$92

The robe is deep ruby in colour with purple glints. The nose reveals aroma of white pepper and figs, with perfectly integrated blueberry notes.

IT3 2017 Aldo Conterno
Barbera d'Alba Conca
Tre Pile
Pietmont

S\$85

Soft tannins and a pinch of fresh acidity that breaks apart the wine's rich fruit flavors. The hot vintage has taken well to the Barbera grape, accentuating its volume, richness and generosity. The bouquet offers black fruit, dried plum, spice, truffle-infused earth and toasted hazelnut.

Deep, dark fruit with a mingling of spice, tar and smoke.

US3 2016 St Innocent
Shea Vineyard

Heady, mineral-and spice-accented red and blue fruit, incense and a sexy floral nuance on the seductively perfumed nose. offering intense black raspberry, cherry liqueur, spicecake and candied rose flavors and a building suggestion of Asian spices on the back half. Finishes silky & long.

US4 2017 Napanook
Napa Valley

Deep purple-black in color, it springs from the glass with vivacious notions of warm black cherries, blackberry compote and crushed black currants with touches of dark chocolate.

US5 2017 HdV Californio
Syrah
Willemette Valley

S\$145

Silky tannins add to its sheer appeal. Dark blue/purplish fruit, spice, licorice and menthol are some of the many notes that open in the glass.

NEW ZEALAND

NZ2 20Te Mata Estate
Gamay Noir
Hawke's bay

There are dark roses, raspberries, and notes of sandal wood and liquorice. Soft red and black summer fruits are balanced here by a thirst-quenching freshness.

NZ3 2018 Te Mata Estate
Coleraine

Outlining notes of tobacco, earth and cassis with cedar and baking spices. Of course, the fruit is more intense than in most Bordeaux wines, showing ample freshness to while the medium to full-bodied palate is silky, framed by fine-grained tannins that give shape and length to the finish.
